Education Programme

For many years now, as well as the rescue and rehoming work, which we appreciate is at best first aid, we have tried to tackle the galgo problem at source.





We have produced an education programme. Our hopes are that this will support the teaching of English in Spanish schools,

educate the children about the plight of the galgos and change the perception people have of these dogs.

The aim is to develop empathy for dogs and help make a difference to the many that are in need of loving homes.

Hopefully this will encourage more Spanish people to adopt a galgo as a family pet. So many are often abandoned or killed after their usefulness as a hunting dog is over.

We have an education website to support the current materials and we have a GalGo! game, available to download for free on the Google Play Store. Just click and search for GalGo!

Galgos (breed name galgo español) are Spanish bred greyhounds used widely by hunters in the rural areas of Spain, for coursing the hare with betting but the season is only 4 months after which time they are abandoned or brutally killed.

Many have not been handled kindly, some have suffered in overcrowded shelters in Spain, making them wary of other dogs, and some need gentle socialisation and a lot of reassurance that they are never going to be hungry or hurt again.

They were rescued in the first place by volunteers who themselves suffer the hostility of their own countrymen for showing such concern and care.

We home most of our rescues in mainland Europe but a small percentage we bring to the UK to help share the load. All our dogs are wormed, vaccinated, microchipped and sterilised/castrated before they arrive.

Greyhounds and galgos make excellent family pets, and, contrary to popular opinion, their requirements for exercise are moderate and many can live happily with cats.
