They are now settling with their new families and it is lovely to receive photos and news of their progress for us to put on our website, Facebook etc so that our supporters can see the dogs helped by their kind donations to GIN.

We are pleased that our education material is being downloaded regularly by many in Spain. After a recent visit to Arca de Noe in Albacete three children collected 30€ on their own to buy things for the animals cared for at the shelter and made a special visit to hand over their donation.

The children love to take part in the many activities that we have on our website and it is always hard to pick the winners from the many competition entries we receive. Galgo Pietro (right) is one of the prizes they can win and he is proving to be very popular.



We continue with funding for projects in Spain and are pleased to report that the sensory garden project at Galgos del Sol, in memory of our Founder, Anne Finch, is now complete. This garden will help Tina and her team rehabilitate the galgos giving them a quiet, calm area away from the main kennels to socialise and gain confidence with new surroundings and people.

We have also funded the purchase of clinic equipment for the new clinic at 112carlotagalgos in Malaga, run by Charlotte. We visited earlier this year and Leigh, one of our Trustees, himself a vet, was able to discuss the clinic and equipment with Rosa and Charlotte and we have funded the purchase of some veterinary equipment to aid their work.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank our supporters and volunteers for all their hard work during the year which enables us to continue our work for the greyhounds and galgos.

Also a big thank you to the shelters and adoption groups who work tirelessly caring for the dogs and finding homes for them.
